



City of Pearland FILM PERMIT APPLICATION

A film permit is required for motion picture or television production, or commercial materials of any kind which includes the use of any public street, road, right-of-way, public facility or public place owned by the City, or over which the City has the right of control. A film permit is not required for any filming at an established fixed place of business within the City. A film permit is not required for filming or videotaping of persons, scenes, occurrences or events, which are done for news gathering purposes in the general public interest, for use in criminal investigations by law enforcement agencies, or for use in any judicial proceedings.

The public property to which the permit relates shall at all times be made accessible to fire, police, or other emergency personnel for public health, safety, or welfare.

The permittee shall not block or close any streets, sidewalks or alleys.

The permittee shall not in any way interfere with traffic or pedestrian right of ways.

The permittee shall be responsible for restoring any area used pursuant to a permit to the same condition it was in prior to use by the permittee.

The permittee is required to include the City of Pearland in production credits for filming or videotaping.

Costs incurred in the use of City equipment or any assignment of City employees, including Police and Fire personnel must be reimbursed to the City by the permittee.

A certificate of insurance is required prior to issuance of the film permit. The certificate of insurance must contain combined single limit coverage for bodily injury and property damage of not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000), and basic workers' compensation insurance as provided in the laws of the state. The certificate shall name the City as additional insured. The City may require additional coverage if it is determined that the risks inherent in the proposed activity, would not be adequately covered, by the basic coverage.

A certificate of insurance is required prior to issuance of the film permit. Please do not submit your application without a certificate of insurance which has combined single limit coverage for bodily injury and property damage of not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000).
